The challenges of Shikoku, the smallest of Japan's four main islands, have many commonalities with regional challenges faced in all other parts of Japan.

This is both from geographical aspects as well as from the relationship between cities and the countryside.

The significance of a network that promotes sustainable communities based on biodiversity (natural capital) in Shikoku serves not only as a means of solving challenges within Shikoku, but also as an effective reference for solving regional challenges in other parts of Japan.
